PECC Workforce Development Collaborative (PWDC)

The Pediatric Emergency Care Coordinator (PECC) Workforce Development Collaborative (PWDC) is enrolling participants now through today, August 1, 2021. The mission of this national collaborative, led by the Emergency Medical Services for Children Innovation and Improvement Center (EICC), is to support healthcare professionals working in prehospital and emergency department systems to become effective pediatric champions (also known as PECCs). The program, which will run from September 2021 through June 2022, is open to anyone with an interest in ensuring ill and injured children receive high-quality care in their community. Pediatric-specific training or experience is not required, and participants do not need to be involved in direct patient care. The time commitment is approximately three hours each month.
